Go to Google and put **maths investigations** in the search. (Notice the 's' on Maths)




Click on the link for *mathsinvestigations.com*.

'Getting the App'


If you are using a tablet (like an iPad) you can get Maths Investigations 'as an App'.

[Note: For the tech-savvy among you, it is not actually an App, it is a shortcut. But as far as the children are concerned, it looks like an App, so it is an App!]


Here's how to do it for the iPad. If you have a different tablet there will be something similar. (Note that you **don't** visit any App store for this.)

First make sure you are on this page.


Click on this icon.



Click on Add to Home Screen.



Click on Add.



You will then have the App.



Note: To use it you need to be connected to your Wifi.
